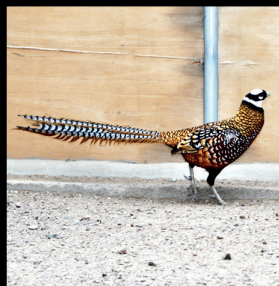
OUR Works In FARM



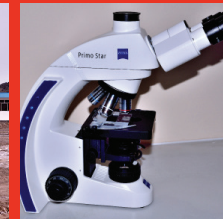
WHAT WE ARE DOING ?

ONE OF OUR BASIC GOALS IS PROTECTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND NATURE. WE ARE TRYING TO PREVENT FROM EXTINCTION OF ANIMALS AND BIRDS, SPECIALLY HUBARA BIRDS. THEREFORE, WE BUILT A SPECIAL BUILDING FOR BREEDING OF HUBARA AND OTHER BIRDS.

AL-Gharrafa foundation leased 160 Hectare for 30 years from Islamic Republic of Afghanistan government. This land is located in khair Abad desert of Farah province. Main activities in this land are bird breeding and planting trees. At first, due to achieving our agriculture goals, it needed to prepare land. Therefore, AGF start necessary construction work in this land. For instance, construction of 5000 m boundary wall, building of hangers, digging of water wells, building guard rooms and guard towers, construction a building for workers, building bathrooms, septic tanks, installing solar system, room for solar system, constructing a building for bird breeding center, constructing a building for falcon, animal cages and some other construction work. It is mentioned more than 50 persons including Engineering board, administrative staff, veterinarians, skilled workers, farmers and guards are working in this farm.



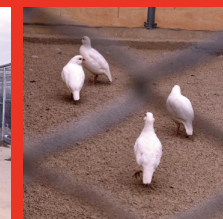
3 places

This building is furnished with a standard laboratory and equipment. Up to now six veterinarians were hired and trained in Qatar. These expert veterinarians are running a bird breeding center in the agriculture farm.



Beside the bird breeding center, another special building was constructed for falcons. Different types of falcons are kept in this place.



In addition, there was built more than 400 cages, a place for animals in an open area (400m * 60m), shelters because of sunlight and etc.
